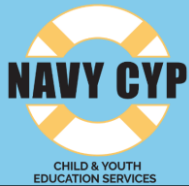

COMMAND SPOTLIGHT

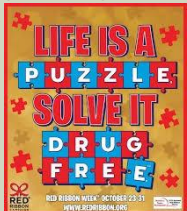
Over the last year NS GTMO's Security Department has...

- Provided direct support to OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM, the White House' Office of Military Commissions and the establishment of OPERATION SOUTHERN GUARD.
- NSF's outstanding efforts delivered vital Force Protection measures through an array of landside, waterborne, and C-sUAS resources during the processing and transport of Illegal Immigrants. In coordination with (2) Joint Task Forces and Department of Homeland Security personnel, NSF efforts led 75 High and Low Threat Illegal Alien Missions, 1,240 man-hours and the safe transport of 914 illegals.
- Access Control and Vehicle Registration Offices processed over 7k background investigations, 2.2k vehicles registrations and 2.5k identification badges
- Military Working Dog teams provided direct security support for distinguished visitors to include Executive Branch members, Cabinet-Level officials, Congressional Delegations, the Commandant of USMC and Commander SOUTHCOM; their efforts reinforced the safe arrival, stay and departure of 27 distinguished visitors.
- In preparations for Commander, Naval Installations Command (CNIC) Final Evaluation Problem and certification of Naval Security Forces, our Integrated Training Teams executed over 20 integrated training sessions and exercises, contributing to the protection of critical assets, mission readiness, and natural disasters preparedness, response, and recovery.

- ❖ We meet the 1st Thursday of each month at 1800 in the Scout Hut off of 6th St in Villamar.

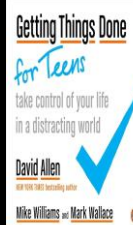
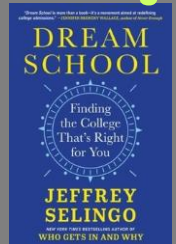
